## **Anti-Slavery Policy**

We expect our suppliers to ensure that child labor is not used in the performance of work conducted for Adtell Integration. They are expected to also put in place adequate procedures to ensure that no form of modern slavery, including but not limited to, forced labor, debt bondage, slavery or trafficking of persons is conducted by themselves or those within their own supply chain.
